On December 8, 2023 the above-named defendant was released pending sentencing on a violation of supervised release. The Court ordered all previously imposed conditions of release along with these additional conditions:

Upon release, the defendant shall report directly to Erie County Medical Center and request a psychiatric evaluation. The defendant shall abide by any treatment recommendations, including adherence to medications that may be prescribed. The defendant shall provide the probation office with any discharge or treatment documentation that is produced.

The defendant shall participate in a counseling session with Assistant Federal Public Defender Frank Passafiume to be educated on legal issues related to communications including social media and written correspondence.

The defendant shall not send to anyone any item via postal service or any other delivery service, with the exception of ink on paper, without the approval of the probation officer.

The defendant shall not have any contact, directly or indirectly, including through social media, telephone, text, mail, or email, with Nathan Leaver, without the approval of the probation officer.

The defendant shall comply with the conditions of the Location Monitoring Program (home detention component). This will be monitored by a Global Positioning Satellite System and the defendant shall wear and/or carry (an) electronic monitoring device(s) and shall follow the monitoring procedures as outlined in Probation Form 61. The defendant is required to contribute to the cost of services rendered (co-payment).

ORDER OF THE COURT

It is ordered that the defendant is released pending sentencing on his violation charges with the above-noted additional conditions.
